

## Livingston County Golf Association 4 Person Scramble

Location: Woodlynn Hills

Date: June 10th

### Eligibility

Entries are open to all male / female amateur golfers who are age 18 & over by May 6, 2017

### Entry Fee

\$200 per 4 Person Team

Entry Fees Includes- Cart, Hot Dog and Drink on the turn, and Prizes

### Format

Competition will be 18 holes of stroke play. It will be a scramble format for each team. Each player tees off with the best drive selected and marked. All players will then play the next shot from within a score card length of the mark. Any ball selected requires each player to play the next shot from the same condition. This process will continue until the team holes out to complete each hole. Each player must use his/her tee shot at least three times during the 18 holes. A player must not tap in a short putt before his/her partners have attempted their shot. Once the ball is holed, the team's score is fixed.

- There will be One Men's Flight and One Women's Flight
- Tournament will be limited to a maximum of 30 teams
- This is a Scratch Only Event
- Men aged 18 to 69 will play from the Blue Tees
- Men aged 70 and over will play from the White Tee
- All Women will play from the Red Tees
- Winners will be the low Men's Total and the Low Women's Total
- There will be an Optional Team Skins Game for \$20 per team

### Prizes

- Prizes will be awarded to approximately 1/3 of the field in both the Men's and Women's division
- Tie scores will be awarded the equal division of the combined prizes for those places
- Prizes will be in the form of cash and shop gift cards
- If No Skins are won, then each team will receive their \$20 back.
